Only candidates fulfilling the domicile requirements (for States/ UTs mentioned at Para 1) and eligibility conditions, reporting at recruitment rally venues upto 10 AM (cut-off-time) on reporting dates as mentioned above at para 1 shall be permitted in the recruitment test.

Note:- Candidates are to report at their respective rally venues on scheduled dates/ time without fail. They have to cater for any contingencies including late running of trains/ buses/ flights while planning their move.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

3. Date of Birth Block.

3.1. Candidate born between 02 July 2005 and 02 January 2009 (both dates inclusive) are eligible to appear in the recruitment rally.

3.2. In case, a candidate clears all the stages of the selection procedure, then the upper age limit as on date of enrolment should be 21 years.

4. Marital Status and Pregnancy. Only unmarried candidates (male and female) will be eligible for enrolment as Agniveervayu and they shall undertake not to marry during the defined engagement period of four years. Keeping in view limited period of engagement of Agniveervayu inclusive of training, skill development activities, practical as well as formative assessment and organisational requirement of continued service of Agniveervayu during the engagement period, longer absence of Agniveervayu during the engagement period will adversely affect the operational efficiency of the Indian Air Force. Agniveervayu who marry during the said period shall be discharged from the service. Further, only unmarried Agniveervayu will be eligible for selection in regular cadre as Airman. Female candidates additionally shall be required to undertake not to get pregnant during the engagement period of four years. Such female Agniveervayu on becoming Low Medical Category (LMC) due to pregnancy shall be liable to be discharged from service. Pregnancy will debar the female Agniveervayu for selection into Regular Cadre. At the time of enrolment, candidates shall require to sign a voluntary undertaking accepting above conditions.

5. Educational Qualification (Other than Science Subjects).

Candidate should have passed Intermediate/ 10+2/ Equivalent Examination in any stream/ subjects from Education Boards recognised by Central/ State/ UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

OR

Passed two years Vocational Course from Education Boards recognised by Central/ State/ UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate/Matriculation if English is not a subject in Vocational Course).

OR

Passed Three years Diploma Course in Engineering (Mechanical / Electrical/ Electronics/

Automobile/ Computer Science/ Instrumentation Technology/ Information Technology) from Central, State and UT recognised Polytechnic Institute with 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Diploma Course (or in Intermediate/Matriculation, if English is not a subject in Diploma Course).

Note-1:- Education Boards recognised by Central, State and UT as on date of selection test shall only be permitted.

Note-2:- Exact aggregate percentage of marks before decimal as written in the marks sheet of 10+2/ Intermediate/ Equivalent Examination/ Three years Diploma Course/ Two years vocational course OR calculated as per the rules of concerned Education Board/ Polytechnic Institute shall only be considered (For example 49.99% should be taken as 49% and not to be rounded off to 50%).

6. Domicile Requirement. To be eligible to appear in the recruitment rally at Aizawl (Mizoram), Guntur (Andhra Pradesh) and Shillong (Meghalaya) the candidates shall be required to satisfy the following conditions:-

6.1. Permanent Domicile of the districts of States as mentioned at para 1.1., 1.2. and 1.3. shall produce the domicile certificate issued by any Gazetted Officer in Revenue Department or any other official authorised by the State Government of the particular State, prior to commencement of examination.

6.2. Children of serving Air Force personnel [Officer/ Airmen/ NCs(E) and Unit cadre Civilians paid from Defence Estimates] whose father/ mother is presently serving in any Air Force Unit/ any other Organisation located in the districts of States as mentioned at para 1.1., 1.2. and 1.3. irrespective of their domicile status, shall be permitted to appear in the rally subject to production of latest COAFP (Children of Air Force Personnel) Certificate (format available on <https://agnipathvayu.cdac.in>).

6.3. Children of Air Force personnel [Officers/ Airmen/ NCs(E) and Unit Cadre Civilians paid from Defence Estimates] whose father/ mother is Retired/ Discharged/ Deceased and they are residing in the districts of States as mentioned at para 1.1., 1.2. and 1.3. shall be permitted to appear in the rally subject to production of proof of minimum stay of one year along with original and photocopy of Service Book/ Discharge Book/ Casualty Service Certificate/ Service Particular Certificate (issued from DPO-3/ DAV, as applicable) in case of Officers/ Airmen/ NCs(E) and a Certificate duly signed by OIC Civil Admin and countersigned by CO/ C Adm O of the last served unit, in case of Civilians.

7. Mandatory Medical Standards. General Medical Standards for Agniveervayu male & female candidates are as follows:-

7.1. Height.

7.1.1. For Male Candidates. Minimum acceptable height is 152 cms.

7.1.2. For Female Candidates. Minimum acceptable height is 152 cms. For candidates belonging to North East or hilly regions of Uttarakhand, a lower minimum height of 147 cms will be accepted. In case of candidates from Lakshadweep, the minimum height will be 150 cms.

Note:- Female candidates availing height relaxation for being domicile of North East/ hilly regions of Uttarakhand/ Lakshadweep are to submit domicile certificate with endorsement of domicile status at the time of recruitment rally. 7.4. Hearing. Candidate should have normal hearing i.e. able to hear forced whisper from a distance of 6 meters by each ear separately.

7.5. Dental. Should have healthy gums, good set of teeth and minimum 14 dental points. Dental Implants and Implant Supported Prosthesis will not be awarded any dental points. Candidates wearing fixed or removable orthodontic appliances will be declared unfit.
