developing skills and learning and appreciation of other fields. An engineer would not develop good communication skills, an accountant would not know anything about psychology or law and a language teacher would not understand fundamentals of science or basics of calculations. Education begins primarily by developing an individual. It is a forgone conclusion that if individuals are well-developed and act responsibly, society and the world will be taken care automatically. An individual is like a cell that together makes society or the world and if each cell is healthy, the entire body will be healthy, but if some of the cells catch disease, gradually the entire body will be infected. This idea of all round development including physical work, developing mental and spiritual resilience was propounded in ancient Indian traditions and educational system. This was given a systematic and concrete shape by Gandhiji in the Twentieth Century through his idea of 'Nai Talim'. Gandhiji also stressed the importance of interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary study, though the words were not in vogue then. He also gave the importance of societal work for a student to make the student a responsible future citizen.

Dr. Barry Marshall's experience is a great one in change resistance and acceptance. He was a physician from rural area of Australia. He never had, on hand, the sophisticated laboratories of Europe and America. With his interest and knowledge, he discovered that ulcers are caused by the bacterium *H. Pylori* and can be cured by antibiotic medication. His discovery contradicted the conventional medical wisdom and practice. It was believed that ulcers were caused by stomach acid brought by spicy foods and stress. A bland diet and stress management were the primary treatment methods. Pharmaceutical companies were enjoying hefty profits from the prescription of Tagmet and Zantac and Mylanta. The medical industry profited hugely from medical examinations, follow-up visits and diagnostic tests. Dr. Marshall's discovery was viewed with scepticism by medical establishment. He had to endure the rejection and severe criticism of his medical papers on the discovery. He was determined to prove his point and bring out the fact that would affect millions of patients. He started treating ulcer patients with antibiotic on a large scale. In the sensational result, eighty percent of the patients were cured forever by using commonly-used medication. The mighty medical establishment accepted and re-wrote the books. Dr. Marshall's discovery and his tenacity against change resistance ended the expensive and painful long-term suffering of most ulcer patients.
